



Dr. Thorben Huth of the Insutute of Pathology of the University of Heidelberg is the winner of the 2021 Mia Neri Award.



The award is given every year by the European Society of Human Genetics (ESHG) to a young investigator presenting a study in the field of oncology during the annual conference of the Society. Dr. Huth presented a study on hepatocellular carcinoma, demonstrating that loss of specific genes localized in the short arm of chromosome 8 is critical for the growth and metastasis of the tumor and that targeted correction of this defect may lead to the development of novel therapeutic approaches. The Mia Neri Foundation congratulates Dr. Huth for this accomplishment and wishes him all the best for future endeavors in the field of cancer research.
