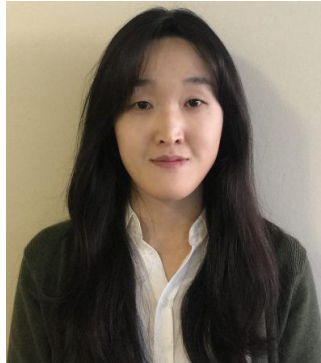

A NEW RESEARCH PROJECT FUNDED

Earlier this year the Mia Neri Foundation published a call for the proposal of research projects in the field of childhood brain tumors. Twelve proposals, received from different countries, were evaluated by expert external reviewers. The winning project, awarded a grant of **100,000 €**, is entitled

“Vascular mimicry: Assessing the existence and the mechanism of the internal channel formation in glioblastoma with human brain tumors on chip”

presented by Dr. **Taeyun Kang** (photo) of the Biomedical Engineering, Systems Biology Institute, Yale University, New Haven, CT (USA).

The project is highly innovative and technologically advanced, promising to deliver significant results and new insights into the pathophysiology of brain tumors, ultimately favoring the discovery of an effective cure.
